What are we going to be learning?

We will be learning all about long ago when dinosaurs lived. We will use lots of information books as well as the internet to find out about different dinosaurs. There will be lots of long words for us to find out about and practise saying! Reception children will be learning about carnivores and herbivores and using books and the internet to find out what different dinosaurs ate. We will use the information we find to make a class information book about dinosaurs. We will do lots of work about size, as well as counting and number problems. We will use our creative skills to make our own dinosaurs and write a caption for them.

We will all continue to practise our speaking and listening skills by talking about the different dinosaurs, saying why we like or don't like them and using the new dinosaur vocabulary we have learnt.

What will the hook be?

A large egg appears- what could be inside?

How will we celebrate learning outcomes?

A dinosaur display.

Talk to your children about long, long ago. Share dinosaur stories and information books with your child. Help your child say the long dinosaur names. Help your child use the internet to find out about dinosaurs. Bring any information you find into to school to share with the class.
