### **Foundation Stage**

This week we have welcomed our Nursery children into school. They are all settling well and beginning to find their way around. Most Reception children are now staying all day. Be prepared for some tired children at 3 o'clock on Friday! Robins and Puffins have drawn a picture of themselves in their new book. They have tried to hold the pencil with a tripod grip. They have also been outside in the Muddy Kitchen this week using one handed tools to make all sorts of mixtures!

#### Year 1

We have had another fabulous week. We started our English learning journey this week reading Charlie's Superhero Underpants. We created a 'Charlie' of our own and used adjectives to describe his appearance and his personality. Ask the children what an adjective is as they have loved learning the proper term for a describing word! Thank you so much for such a wonderful turn out of costumes on Monday, we loved seeing all of them!

#### Year 2

Our theme is The Enormous Crocodile by Roald Dahl. We've been looking at expanding noun phrases and adjectives. The children have chosen a character from the book and have started planning a character profile.



In Maths we have been looking at place value and partitioning numbers into 10's and 1's.
