## Weeks 30<sup>th</sup> October- 4<sup>th</sup> December

## What are we going to be learning?

The rich texts we will be using through this topic are 'Blue Penguin' and 'Frozen Planet' Through these books the children will be learning to write setting and character descriptions and diary entries with a short narrative. They will learning to write a non-fiction leaflet using facts. Through these genres of writing, the children will be learning to punctuate sentences correctly, spell keywords correctly use adjectives and 'and' appropriately in sentences.

Through maths, the children will be learning to use fractions ½, 1/4 and 1/3. They will be learning to solve number problems using variety of resources to prove the answer. These might include, number lines, tens and dienes and numicon.

Through the topic 'Antarctica' the children will be learning about where Antarctica is in the world using Google Earth and learning about the animals that live in Antarctica. In Art and Design, the will be drawing a still life and making a penguin. They will be exploring songs and chants in music and sharing these with some of the year reception children.

In Science, the children will be thinking about habitats and they will be able to plant bulbs in the raised flowerbeds.

What will the hook be?	How will we celebrate learning outcomes?
The children will be visiting Marwell Zoo at the beginning of the theme. This will support the children's learning about habitats and climates and in particular about penguins.	At the end of the theme the children will celebrate the theme by displaying and showing the year one children their writing, art work and design and technology skills.
