Please be vigilant especially if you have older siblings that may be watching or playing these films or games.



Year One Reading:

There has been a slight change to book change frequency in Year One. The children are changing their book twice a week now as they are now learning to build fluency with a text and understand comprehension questions about the text. Please keep reading with your child and begin to ask the children questions about the text. Here are a few examples:

- Who are the characters?
- Where is the story set?
- What is your favourite part? Why?
- What do you think will happen next?
