Robins and Puffins have been using their phonic knowledge to help them write a sentence about a snowy picture.

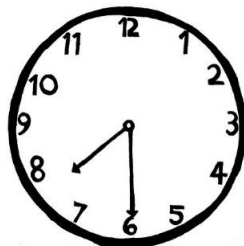


Year 1
